Re: Direct Energy Regulated Services Regulated Rate Tariff Attestation Letter

Please accept this letter as confirmation that I have reviewed the rates to be filed by DERS for the month of May 2019. My concurrence with the calculated rates is based on DERS’ review of all of the calculations for the various rate components and I affirm that the rates have been determined in accordance with the Energy Price Setting Plan (“EPSP”) for 2016 to 2018, as approved by the Commission on August 30, 2017, in Decision 21295-D01-2017 (“the Decision”).

I also confirm that the calculations are based on procurement of products at or better than target prices for the regulated rate, are correct and that these prices represent forward prices during January 2, 2019 to April 23, 2019 for 7x24 and 7x16 products.

I further affirm that for May 2019, 100 percent of the portfolio is supplied through procurement as set out in the Decision, totaling 88,040 MWh, with the percentages by source as set out in the following table, and there was no requirement to invoke the backstop mechanism. There were 10 MWs self-supplied for May 2019.
