Re: Direct Energy Regulated Services Regulated Rate Tariff Attestation Letter

Please accept this letter as confirmation that I have reviewed the rates to be filed by DERS for the month of March 2020. My concurrence with the calculated rates is based on DERS’ review of all of the calculations for the various rate components and I affirm that the rates have been determined in accordance with the Energy Price Setting Plan (“EPSP”) for 2018 to 2020, as approved by the Commission on May 22, 2019, in Decision 24296-D01-2019 (“the Decision”).

I also confirm that the calculations are based on procurement of products at or better than target prices for the regulated rate, are correct and that these prices represent forward prices during, November 4, 2019, to, February 21, 2020, for 7x24 and 7x16 products.

I further affirm that for March 2020, 100 percent of the portfolio is supplied through procurement as set out in the Decision, totaling 100,325 MWh, with the percentages by source as set out in the following table, and there was no requirement to invoke the backstop mechanism. There was no energy self-supplied for March 2020.
